

The following are new operating procedures that are both mandated and best practices for golf within Newfoundland & Labrador

Guests are asked to respect physical distancing of other golfers and staff. Please stay a minimum of two (2) meters away from other people AT ALL TIMES



Tee time Reservations

Guests will be asked to make all reservations online. Walk on golf will not be permitted.



Clubhouse – Masks Are Mandatory

Due to Government COVID Regulations masks are to be worn inside the clubhouse. If using the restaurant you must wear a mask until seated at your table. Once seated you may remove your mask. It must be replaced anytime you move around or leave your table.



Golf Carts - Single Rider Per Cart

Golf carts are single rider unless the passenger is in your Bubble. If sharing a cart one person will be required to pay for the full cart

Only authorized riders can have a bag on cart

Staff will disinfect all points of contact after each use for the next rider.

When completing play please do not proceed past the sign indicating **No Carts Beyond This Point**.



On Course

Wait to be called to first tee by course staff.

DO NOT TOUCH on course items such as: The Flag Stick, Signage, Tee Markers, and Machinery

Pin MUST remain in the hole

Follow golf club signage and staff directions

Gatherings of any size are not permitted. Please leave the Golf Course as promptly and safely as possible.

Anyone failing to follow guidelines will be removed from the property immediately
